- The DNR requires all vehicles to have a parking sticker to park on the grounds, regardless if you are camping or not.
- If you are a resident of the State of Michigan you must have a Recreation Passport affixed to your vehicle
- If you are a non-resident or do not have the required Recreation Passport you must complete the self-registration form and submit the appropriate fees. The forms will be located on the green stand by the guard rail. The DNR will be actively checking for compliance with this state requirement.
