



If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only", fee \$22.00. per dog. In making entries for "Brace Class Only" full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as a part of a Brace **MUST** be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes - "Brace Class". If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated "Brace No. 1", "Brace No 2", etc.

NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

Thursday, Saturday & Sunday

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a celebration of the dedication and enthusiasm of owner-handlers and is open to purebred dogs that are at least six months of age. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. **A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

FREE TO ENTER. During the lunch break, children between 5 years to under 9 years can join the fun of dog showing. The new class is being offered to inspire your handlers to love and show their dogs. This event is for "exhibition only" and there will be no placements of the entries. All children will receive the same participation award from the judge. Pre-entry is encouraged. Limited to 15 children. Day of Show entries will be accepted if entries are not filled. Dogs are to be AKC recognized breed and at least 4 months old. Children enter the ring with their dog one at a time. For more information for Saturday, contact Janie Hecker jhecker@ptd.net 484-239-5109

For more information for Sunday, contact Cheryl Burns burns_cc@yahoo.com or 610-233-6849. Prior to the beginning of the class, the responsible adult will sign a RELEASE OF LIABILITY FORM. Check-in or enter Saturday at the LVKC and Sunday at the BCKC Table by 11:00 A.M. Each child will receive a Rosette and a treat/snack bag.

- Child must be between the ages of five and nine years old.
- A dog must be at least four months of age to enter the Pee Wee Class
- Bitches in season will not be allowed to participate. If pre-entered, a dog may be substituted that meets the eligibility requirements as specified by the club.
- All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar.
- A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside of the ring.
- All AKC full recognized, Miscellaneous and FSS Breeds are eligible for this event including dogs with a PAL listing.
- The AKC registered pure bred dogs must be registered to participate.
- A release must be signed by the child's parent or legal guardian. This release will be available on site and must be signed before going into the ring.

The safety of both the dogs and Juniors inside and outside the ring is a primary concern. Outside of the ring, the dog is to be controlled by the adult accompanying the child.

An additional lead, provided by the Club, will be at the Judge's table. At the judge's discretion based upon the size of the child and the dog, for safety purposes the adult may be asked to attach a second lead to the dog so both child and adult will walk the dog together.

RAMP INFO

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp through all levels of competition: AMERICAN WATER SPANIEL; BOYKIN SPANIEL; ENGLISH SPRINGER SPANIEL; FIELD SPANIEL; NS DUCK TOLLING RETRIEVER; WELSH SPRINGER SPANIEL; BASENJI (or Table) (Ramp eff. 10/ 1/ 25); GRAND BASSET GRIFFON VENDEEN; WHIPPET; GERMAN PINSCHER; PORTUGUESE WATER DOG; STANDARD SCHNAUZER; AMERICAN STAFFORDSHIRE TERRIER; IRISH TERRIER; MINIATURE BULL TERRIER (Ground/Table); SOFT COATED WHEATEN TERRIER; STAFFORDSHIRE BULL TERRIER; FINNISH SPITZ; AUSTRALIAN CATTLE DOG; ENTLEBUCHER MOUNTAIN DOG; FINNISH LAPPHUND; ICELANDIC SHEEPDOG; MUDI (or Table); NORWEGIAN BUHUND; POLISH LOWLAND SHEEPDOG; PULI (or Table); SPANISH WATER DOG; BASSET FAUVE DE BRETAGNE (Misc.); NORRBOTTENSPET (Misc.)

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: CLUMBER SPANIEL; LAGOTTO ROMAGNOLO; SUSSEX SPANIEL; BASSET HOUND; CIRNECO DELL'ETNA; KERRY BLUE TERRIER; BULLDOGS; CHINESE SHAR-PEI; CHOW CHOW; KEESHOND; SPANISH WATER DOG

This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4–6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions. Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed.

In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breed. (6/12/25)

Entry blank MUST be filled out with the necessary information, otherwise the entry in Junior Showmanship will not be accepted.

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS: This Class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 Best Junior wins in an Open Class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. 

The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list, if the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on the entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 14, Section 3).
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience and Rally trials should mark Breed as AKC Canine Partners Listed Dog "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Variety, Breeder, Sire, Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
